On January 23, 2017, the RAIS Dammam Boys section hosted the RAIS Dammam Traffic Safety Committee's Traffic Safety Training for drivers in conjunction with the Saudi Aramco Traffic Safety Volunteers. Mr. Azhar Chaudhary of Saudi Aramco instructed 26 drivers from RAIS on procedures for driving safely in Saudi Arabia.

Ms. Arshi Wahab, RAIS Girls Section Lead Math Teacher, and Ms. Meghan Cannon, RAIS Girls Section Lead Physical Education Instructor, assisted Mr. Azhar in the presentation.
